**WESTERLEIGH ROAD, YATE
SURFACE TREATMENT WORKS 21-23 JULY 2025**

I am writing to advise you about carriageway treatment works that is to be carried on Westerleigh Road, Yate. On the 21ST of July, works will commence between the hours of **09:30 AM to 15:30 PM**.

The works will involve treating the carriageway with a material called Reclamite. This type of surface treatment is preventative maintenance technique, used on roads in fair to good condition, to keep them in this state for several years. It is a sustainable and quick spray treatment that soaks into the road surface, preventing cracks and potholes. We will then cover the road using an aggregate material. This is to give the surface texture and allows the road to be open to traffic as soon as possible. We will return to sweep the road at a later stage.

So that we can complete the work in the safest and quickest way possible, we kindly ask that you park vehicles away from the road. Failure to do this will mean we can't effectively carry out the works.

For the duration of the works, the road will be completely closed, and all traffic will be diverted around the area whilst the closures are in place. We will make every effort to ensure that access to properties and amenities fronting the site and whose only access is from the closed road, is kept available and the disruption to localised residents is kept to a minimum. However, there may be periods of time when access to properties by vehicle will be unachievable, and for this, we apologise. Please note that adverse weather conditions or plant/delivery problems may affect these times and dates.

Pedestrians and cyclists

Please avoid walking on the road while we are working. If you need to cross by our works, get the attention of our supervisor and they will ensure it is safe for you to cross. For your own safety, please avoid walking on the newly treated road for up to two hours. Reclamite can be slippery while it is soaking into the road surface. Cyclists should dismount their bikes when passing this area.

Driving on the road and looking after your vehicle

You will be able to drive on the treated road at a speed of **5mph**. Please abide by this speed limit for your safety. Should there be any specks of material on your vehicle after treatment, this can be removed with any mild solvent/household cleaner. Any material tracked onto drives will disappear within 3 weeks or less. Please drive with caution when the aggregate has been laid.

About Reclamite

- This product is not harmful to humans, pets, wildlife or plants.
- It is environmentally safe.
- Reclamite is used as a preventative maintenance treatment, not a new road project, patch or pothole repair. So once treated, the road may not look any different to you.
- The process prevents potholes and extends the life and condition of the roads by up to 4 years.
